

A Collection of American Constitutions: States Territories, & South America Donated by H. P. Kraus

In December of 1977, H.P. Kraus, a New York antiquarian bookseller and one of the most influential rare book dealers of the 20th century, donated a significant collection of American constitutions to Princeton University. Catalogue 146, *A Collection of American Constitutions: States, Territories, South America* (H.P. Kraus, n.d.), provides a checklist for the 132 items making up the collection. It also serves as a point of departure for a researching American constitutions held in the collections of the Princeton University Library.
